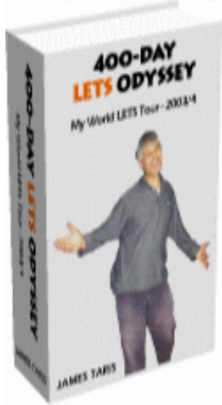

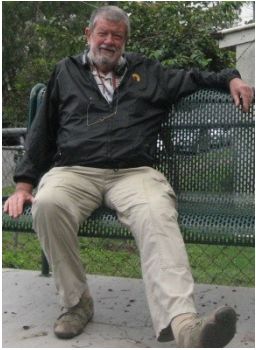

### Think smarter and barter, it beats paying

HAVE you ever yearned to get out of this dog-eat-dog, money-obsessed society? Well, you can't entirely, so snap out of it. But members of a community-based organisation believe they have come as close as it's possible for city slickers to do just that.

Brisbane Local Energy Trading Systems Organisation Inc. (LETS) is an alternative currency system that operates like a community bank, except with totally interest-free credit.

of personal skills from hobbies, life experiences and formal training, can be used to earn LETS units which in turn can be exchanged for goods and services from other members.

Not only can people access goods and services they would not normally be able to afford, they can effectively 'earn' more without the taxman being entitled to his cut.

Brisbane LETS spokeswoman Liz Stanhope said a single unit was roughly the equivalent of \$1 with most services offered for between 10 to 15 units per hour.

She said unlike the Bartercard system, members did not have to pay a cash fee to join.

There were currently 100 members across Brisbane including massage therapists, hairdressers, child-careers and book-keepers.

For retired mechanic Carl Johnson LETS members have pride of place in his Windsor

country childhood where doing favours for others was a way of life. Mr Johnson said between 20 to 30 units for an oil change and brake check.

He said whether they could clean, labour or cook most people had a skill to offer.

"There's one woman who makes a casserole like you wouldn't believe," he said.

A portrait of himself painted by a LETS member has pride of place in his Windsor home.

Imogen Bunting, 34, has moved house and enjoyed massages and other services all without paying a cent.

The Dutton Park resident said many of the LETS members were alternatively-minded but the biggest "capitalist pig" she knew was also a member "because he doesn't like to spend money".

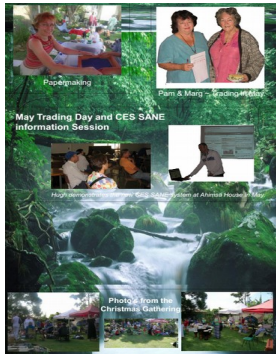
## SANE - struggling with sanity

Liz Stanhope had been doing the Secretary role but 3 people now doing the same role - Membership Secretary, Correspondence Secretary, and Minutes Secretary.

- New newsletter layout and after AGM 31.8.08 held at Russell & Minh's, became Internet based and emailed out. Later hard copies were printed out on demand.
- Hugh set up the Brislets.org.au site with a link to the CES site on the Bega Valley LETS service costing \$110 annually.
- Annual Membership renewal abolished and members had increased from 70 to 99 but much reduced trades due to the changeover to CES without enough thought to those without computers and email. (Had been 200 plus members previously).
- Nov - National Conference held at Ahimsa House in West End, for units, with a sub committee of Hugh, Marg, Gaynor, Maree, Fred, Carl and Adrian. Had outstanding catering by Yasmin, Eiko and Gaynor. Des, Tracy and Byron performed. Financially successful in \$ and Units.

Marg #157 the social coordinator was aiming for monthly social get-togethers separate from trading days.
